Phase 1

Universal Provision.

The universal provision is available to all pupils and includes quality first teaching or high quality teaching. Needs that can be met through practical adaptations may sit at this level.

**Concern raised (by teacher or parent).
Provision and/or intervention applied.
Reviewed over 3 half terms by class teacher.**

EHCP Pathway

EHCP's are for children and young people whose needs go beyond what mainstream schools can offer.

SEN Support will continue even if EHCP is finalised to review termly progress.

The EHCP will be reviewed annually during an EHCP review meeting. Notes from the meeting will be submitted to the local authority.

Phase 2

Targeted Provision.

Children whose needs cannot be met through universal high quality teaching may need more targeted support and provision. These children may be placed on the SEN register and identified as needing SEN support.

Phase 3

Personalised Provision.

Some children have needs that are wide ranging and more complex and they may need more individualised and specialised packages of provision. Some of these children may need an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP..
